CITY OF OTTAWA HERITAGE REGISTRY INITIATIVE

The City of Ottawa has contacted the United Church of Canada via EDGE, to notify the Church that 20 United Church properties located in the City of Ottawa will be recommended to be included as “non-designated listings” on the City’s Heritage Register. The effect of being a ‘non-designated listing” is that the owners of the property listed must give the City 60 days’ notice of any intent to demolish or remove the building. This level of listing does not limit the ability of the owners (Trustees of the congregation) from selling or renovating or altering the property. Congregations in Ottawa who would like to know more about this initiative can contact the City’s Heritage office by phone at 613-580-2463 or email: heritageinventory@ottawa.ca. A report from City heritage staff that recommends the addition of 2500 properties, including 20 belonging to the United Church, will be presented to a meeting of the Built Heritage Sub-Committee on Tuesday June 11, 2019. Members of the public and interested persons will have the opportunity to speak and/or provide written comments on the report at this meeting.

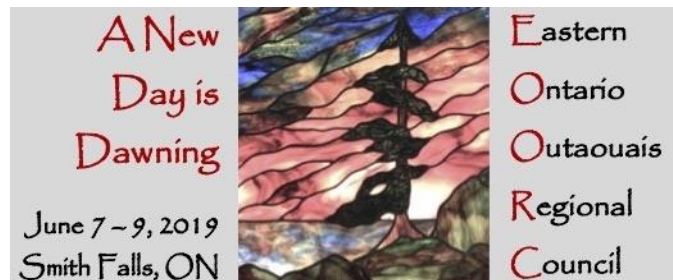
