**From the desk of Drew Presley:** Last year being my first year as part of the committee, I began to wonder about the history of Christmas Cheer here at Rideau Park. With a little help from my friends, I was able to go through our past Annual reports and this is what I learned. As far back as the late seventies, the UCW prepared a small number of hampers, which included, not just groceries, but also knitted mitts, toques and scarfs. The UCW continued to raise money and do this good work throughout the years, and it was noted that some Church families also prepared hampers for families in need. By the mid-eighties the number of hampers being delivered had grown substantially. The Christmas Cheer Program was now one of the many programs of the Church's Social Action and Outreach Committee. Over the last 40 years the Program has consistently provided over 150 families with either hampers or gift cards. Thanks to the coordinating efforts of the Caring and Sharing Program, previously known as Christmas Exchange, the money raised goes to as many people as possible without duplication, and the money raised at the church helps those in our local community.
