HearSay, ringing and choirs: Due to the current Pandemic situation and the Public Health regulations that are in place for Places of Worship, no Thursday night programming will be offered this fall. That means the HearSay dinner for families, Cherub Choir, Joyful Noise Choir, Xpressions Choir, Note-Able Sound Chimes Choir and Grace Notes Teen Bells group are cancelled for the fall term. The adult handbell programs are also suspended for the fall term, and the adult Chancel Choir will not be meeting in person either.
