**Jesus set his face to Jerusalem**

**Lk 9:1-** Jesus sends out disciples to heal and spread good news, rather than doing it himself

**Lk 9:18** – he worried about who the disciples and others thought he was

**Lk 9:22-** he had ominous news (not good news) for his disciples

**Lk 9:41-** Jesus got frustrated with his followers

**Lk 9:46** ff- he broke with social standing by saying that followers must be like children – the least important in the family structure, there was to be no home or supports, they would need to leave their family and all the protection and support it provides



**Luke 9:51 (NRSV)**

<sup>51</sup> When the days drew near for him to be taken up, he set his face to go to Jerusalem.

**How confused the disciples must have been. Jesus seemed very different. How do/might we react/feel when some aspect of our faith is drastically altered? When we come to understand Jesus or our life of faith in a way that makes us uncomfortable?**

**Jesus used his assets and skills, his life differently. Are we ready to use our assets and skills, our lives differently in service of love?**
