Funding Available from the Rideau Park Foundation Fund for Ministry - Applications are now being received for new project funding from the Rideau Park Foundation. Projects eligible for Foundation funds include those which involve experimenting with new or new approaches to ministry, outreach in our community, leadership development, special projects, and property renewal projects. Foundation funds are not intended to meet ongoing operational requirements of current projects/programs. Any member or long-term adherent of Rideau Park United Church may apply, but applications must be sponsored by a committee of the church who will oversee the finances of the project. Approximately \$6,109 is available for disbursement in 2018. **Applications are due by March 29, 2018** and should be submitted to the Church Administrator, Debi Brown (administrator@rideaupark.ca) for the attention of the Chair of Council, Marcia Gosse. Applications may be submitted electronically or in paper form. Please note that funds will not be disbursed until after Council makes decisions on the applications at its April 18 meeting.

Social Action and Outreach and Pastoral Care Committees are joining together to present a program on **April 15** to learn about the "**Compassionate Listening Project**", a non-profit organization dedicated to empowering individuals and communities to transform conflict and strengthen cultures of peace. Our Speaker **Dr. Sharon Gubbay Helfer** is an oral historian and a scholar-practitioner of difficult dialogues. Dr. Gubbay Helfer is a Research Associate with the Centre for Oral History and Digital Storytelling at Concordia University where she worked on the project "Life Stories of Montrealers Displaced by War, Genocide, and other Human Rights Violations". She is a fellow of Concordia's Centre for Ethnographic Research and Exhibition in the Aftermath of Violence (CEREV).and a scholar-practitioner of difficult dialogues with an ongoing personal and professional engagement in understanding the nature of forgiveness, empathy, restorative justice and related themes. Lunch will be served.

Fitness to Drive as We Age" presentation by The Council on Aging Ottawa, on **Tuesday, April 17, 2:00 p.m.** at Rideau Park. Age can affect our functional abilities. The decline in faculties begins as early as our 50's, and continues gradually. It is important to understand the physical, perceptual and cognitive changes in order to correct them or know how to compensate. Maximize knowledge and settings of your car through such programs as "55 Alive" and "CarFit". Are you up to date in the rules of the road and are you aware of the process of license renewal at age 80? Know the system, and plan early for the day when you won't be able to drive.

Please keep in mind worshippers who have limited mobility. Parking in the parking spots beside Cunningham makes it easier for them to come to church, so if you don't have the need, please use a parking spot on the Beecroft side. Thanks.

Special Seniors' Communion Service and Tea Party: The Pastoral Care Committee will host its annual Seniors' Communion Service on **April 22 at 3:00 p.m.** People on our Pastoral Care List will be receiving written invitations with offer of transportation. The tea party, which follows provides an opportunity for you to visit with old friends whom you no longer see at regular Sunday services.

Bus will leave Rideau Park at 7:30 a.m. /return at 7:30 p.m. Our first stop is St. Phillips Square where you can make your own way to any downtown attractions. We leave the Square at 2:00 p.m. and head to Fairview Pointe Claire Shopping Mall for some retail therapy and perhaps a late lunch/early dinner. Tickets - \$45.00 per person. Tickets will be sold during coffee hour and through the church office during the week.

Healing Pathway Course: The Phase 1 Healing Pathway Course is being offered right here at Rideau Park, on **May 4 and 5, 2018.** Phase 1 is an introduction to the basic concepts of Christian-centred healing through prayer, meditation and the laying on of hands. It focuses on learning to be a healing presence and an instrument of God's healing power. The registration fee is \$210.00 (half price for people repeating it as a refresher).
