
Rideau Park United Church June 10, 2018

Rideau Park United Church seeks to be a welcoming faith community, inclusive of all, including those of different economic, ethnic, racial and religious backgrounds, sexual orientations and gender identities. We have recently begun a study process with the goal of becoming an Affirming Ministry, as defined by the United Church of Canada.

Rideau Park is hiring two students this summer.

1. Clerical Assistant under Canada Summer Jobs. This position is for 30 hours a week for 8 weeks. The hours would be spread over 5 days except for the week of August 20.

Some of the duties include (but are not limited to):

- a. Providing Sunday childcare for summer Sundays, from the beginning to the end of the work term;
- Serving as congregational coordinator for Camp Awesome August 20-24. This
 includes attending the congregational coordinators meeting, doing preparatory work
 before camp and supervision of child care volunteers including meeting with them to
 review their responsibilities before camp begins;
- c. Reviewing the links on the RPUC website;

- d. Providing coverage for the Administrative Assistant during her vacation
- e. Meeting with community groups and seniors homes to discuss their needs and to enhance our relationship with them;
- f. Working on or creating various databases, spreadsheets, files.

Under the terms of the agreement this position is open to anyone

- a) Between 15 and 30 years of age at the start of employment;
- b) Was registered as a full-time student during the preceding academic year;
- c) Intends to return to school on a full-time basis during the next academic year;
- d) Is a student in a secondary, post-secondary, vocational or technical program;
- 2. Casual Caretaker for five weeks between July 9 and September 12. Duties will include light custodial duties, care and maintenance of the grounds, set up/take down for groups meeting in the church, and other duties as required. The position is for four hours a day five days a week, Monday to Friday, 9:00 a.m. to 1:00 p.m.: July 9 20, August 13 -17 and September 4 12, and August 20 24 (2:00 p.m. to 6:00 p.m.). Some flexibility in the hours is an option for discussion. A retiree would be considered
